2018 Landscape Waste Collection Options

In conjunction with garbage and recycling services, Groot offers landscape waste collection seasonally between April 1st and November 30th.

Weekly Collection

Groot collects landscape waste weekly on the same day as garbage and recycling (Monday).

All landscape waste must be placed in "Kraft" paper bags or plastic containers labeled "landscape waste". Containers cannot exceed 33 gallons or 50 pounds.

Any branches must be cut and bundled with biodegradable natural fiber twine. Bundles cannot exceed 2 feet in diameter by 4 feet long or 50 pounds.

A waste sticker is required for each bag, container, or bundle of landscape waste set out for collection. Stickers cost \$2.60 and are available at Village Hall or online at www.groot.com.

In addition to weekly collection, Groot offers the following landscape waste collection options:

Spring Clean-Up

On April 16th, Groot will offer **FREE** landscape waste collection. Stickers are not required; however, landscape waste must be placed in bags or containers.

One-Time Pick-Up

The one-time pick-up option includes collection of up to six (6) containers of landscape waste for a one-time charge of \$10.50.

Subscription Program

The subscription program includes collection of up to six (6) containers of landscape waste per week (Apr - Nov) for an annual charge of \$95.00.

To schedule a one-time pick-up or to enroll in the subscription program, contact Groot at (877) 404-7668. Groot will bill directly for these services.

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Cart Exchange Program

Residents can request a smaller garbage cart (65 or 35 gallon) or a larger recycling cart (95 gallon).

All requests must be submitted by Friday, March 16th.

Smoke Detectors

Daylight Savings Time begins Sunday, March 11th at 2:00 AM.

Fox Lake and Wauconda Fire encourage residents to change the batteries in their smoke detectors when they change their clocks.

It is estimated that while 90% of households have smoke detectors, one-third have dead or missing batteries.

Building Permits

Residents are reminded to contact the Building Department prior to making improvements to their home or property.

The Village Code requires building permits for many exterior and interior improvements.

Parking Regulations

Pursuant to Village Ordinance, parking is prohibited on all Village streets between 2:00 AM and 6:00 AM.

Parking of vehicles across the sidewalk or blocking driveways and mailboxes is also prohibited.

Vehicles found in violation of these ordinances may be ticketed. The minimum fine is \$50.

From the Mayor...

Two major development projects are currently underway in the Village: Remington Pointe North, a 286-unit subdivision located on Route 12 between Terra Springs and Remington Pointe, and Speedway at the northwest corner of Volo Village Road and Route 12.

Remington Pointe North, which is being developed by CalAtlantic Homes, includes 200 single-family units and 86 active-adult units (55+) with a clubhouse. Amenities include a 3.65 acre park and 55 acres of open space and wetlands. Improvements to the intersection of Route 12 and Brandenburg Road will provide access to the subdivision.

Speedway's development includes two fuel canopies and a 4,600 square foot Speedy Café convenience store. Speedway will also complete various off-site improvements on Volo Village Road including water and sewer extensions, resurfacing, streetscaping, and a monument sign designating the Village's Heritage District.

The Village's Economic Development Committee continues its efforts to recruit development to Volo. In addition to providing goods and services locally, businesses generate sales tax and non-residential property tax dollars, which lessen the property tax burden on residents.
