Village Construction Update; Board Meeting Dates

Historic Area Sewer/Water Installation

Work is nearing completion on this \$2 million project which will provide water and sewer service to the east side of Volo Village Road and McNally Lane.

Thornton's Gas Station

A permit was recently issued for a Thornton's gas station at the corner of Volo Village Road and Route 12. Construction will begin during the summer.

Route 60/Fish Lake Road Intersection

Utility work has begun in preparation for installing a traffic signal at this very busy intersection. It is anticipated that construction

will continue through the summer. In a related item, the Village will assume responsibility for the installation of a signal at 120/Fish Lake Road, including design engineering.

Backwash Storage Tank, South Water Tower

Work continues to install additional storage capacity at the South Water tower in an effort to reduce disposal costs over the long term.

Remington Pointe Repair and Restoration

Work is ongoing in the subdivision to make sidewalk and road repairs prior to completion of the final lift of asphalt through the

subdivision. Some landscape restoration work is able to be completed as well. Work will continue as funding remains available.
